It was on April 9, 2014 the day when the new academic session had started. A student of Class XII came to my office to tell me that I forgot to wish him on his birthday i.e. on April 6, 2014. I know how invaluable is my wishes to him on this special day of his life. Yes, it was true that I could not convey my wishes to him and it made me feel bad..... But that's when I decided I should give him something which would be with him forever.

Sometime in June 2011, I found a boy sitting in the last bench when I had been with Class IX during the Mathematics Period. I did not get much time to interact with him in the first few days, but when I felt that he was gradually adjusting to the new school environment, I gradually developed rapport with him. His written work used to be very untidy, always with a chewing gum in his mouth in and outside the class, didn't know how to sit in a class, would argue with teachers, carried a ball in his hand whether inside or outside the class, often became impulsive and would get verbally with his classmates. His teachers used to tolerate his behavior with the hope that he will definitely change his attitude one day. Yes, it is true that he used to show a lot of 'attitude' which at times became difficult for a teacher with low patience level to tolerate.

Repeated complaints against him by all his teachers

made me take a step forward in dealing with this boy. I always remembered that he wanted to be one of my best students. That's when I had decided to write to him and this was my first note to him written on Jan 29, 2012.

Determined Decision always makes you winner in Life. I want you to do these few things so that your dream of being my best student gets fulfilled.

1. As soon as you get into the bus, wish both the conductor and the driver a very good morning.

2. Once you get into the bus, sit in your allotted place – you can talk in the bus but only in English.

3. Whatever you speak should make sense and no nonsense.

4. In the school, don't break the discipline rules. If you've to go in a line then you need to. You should not come out of the class without any reason.

5. While sitting in the class both your legs should be on the floor.

6. No chewing gum in your mouth at any point of time in the school campus.

7. You need to respect all the teachers in the school.

8. All your work should be up to date.

9. No cheating during exams.

10. No usage of slang words. Exert control of your emotions.

11. No bringing of soft drinks, etc., to the school.

were quite happy with the change noticed in his behavior and the way he is performing in Academics. He told me that it was only because of the note which I gave to him. I could not recall which note he was talking about till he took it out from his wallet. I was surprised for a moment and then he told me that he didn't want to lose my affection at any cost and for that he was ready to change.

I was touched and infact proud to have him as a student in my life. But I did not convey him any of my feelings. I just told him to keep up his efforts in sustaining the positivity

noticed. Gradually he was into his Class X and things became easier as the

boy remained focused on his studies simultaneously working hard at keeping up his target of becoming a good cricketer. He joined a Cricket Academy and in due course got selected for the Saurashtra Under 16 Team and was doing pretty well. Afterwards there did not exist any need for me to remind him about his behavior or any other thing. He excelled in his Class X Board Exams too, took admission in XI Science and in Sept 2013 he was a part of the team of twenty six boys who took part in the 291st National Adventure Program organized by the National Adventure Institute, Pachmarhi, Hoshangabad District in Madhya Pradesh.

Everything went well and this boy who used to have so many problems with everyone, managed to stay there for seven days without any complaint. I was very happy because he spent most of his time with me whenever we used to go on a trek. Here are a few lines from my second note to him:

Earlier I used to have hundreds of things to tell you, but now nothing is coming to my mind. It may be because of the positivity filled with you. Being closely with you in the Adventure Camp made my understanding deeper. Frankly speaking, I did not even expect that you'll be coming to the Adventure Camp. Anyway, sometimes things happen for a reason which we may not know and only God knows.

Will surely accompany you in any such upcoming tours. You have done a lot. It's because of you and my dad, I got to see such comments from you. Thanks sir! Finally, I am very sure that in the last year of his schooling, he'll be able to lead his House as a House Captain. I want to let him know through this write up that his dream of becoming my best student is fulfilled. I wish him success in all his future endeavours.
